Hus School Encampment Rules & Guidelines

- * Someone on staff needs to know where you are at ALL times! We are responsible for you.
 - No one will leave the Encampment grounds. If someone must leave, they must have written permission of a parent/guardian.
 - All vehicles will be off limits from the time camp begins until the time camp ends.
- * Boys will not go into or around the girls' dorm, and girls will not go into or around the boys' dorm.
 - Respect each other's privacy.
- * There is a camp nurse on site. State law requires that all medication (Rx and OTC) be turned in upon arrival. Medications need to be in original containers and will be dispensed by the camp nurse, as prescribed. State law prohibits any medication in the dorms.
 - If you feel ill or have any problems, please tell one of the staff members.
- * Clothing must be suitable and modest. Following most school dress codes should be safe, but if in doubt, ask a director.
 - Please make sure to bring at least one pair of closed-toe shoes for sports.
- * Campers should not have ANY electronic equipment. Camp is a time to get away from the normal interferences of everyday life.
 - Cell phones may be brought (only for limited use and must not be used in the dorms).
- * Ice cream and drinks may be purchased only at "Snack Time." Absolutely no food or drinks are allowed in the dorms!
 - If you bring your own snacks, label them and turn them in at check in.
- * Everyone will participate in clean up duties, including the cleaning of the kitchen and/or dorms, and final camp clean up on the last day of camp.
- * Bicycles may only be ridden on the bike path. Bikers MUST wear helmets. Bikes and all sports equipment must be returned to their proper location after each use.
- * The pond is not an appropriate swimming area and entrance into it is strictly off limits.
- * This Encampment and its equipment belong to you. Take care of it.
- * Any property damage must be reported to Camp Staff and may result in repair or fine. This includes writing on or defacing any camp property, walls, beds, etc.
- * The Encampment has a zero-tolerance policy for bullying, harassment, and violence.
- * The Hus Encampment is a drug free, alcohol free, tobacco free, weapon free, and pet free zone. These items will not be tolerated at the Encampment. This includes vapes and e-cigarettes.
- * The staff reserve the right to contact the parents or guardians of any camper who violates these rules and make arrangements to have the camper leave the Encampment immediately.
